OTHER SMALL FRUIT TREES AND SHRUBS

***Prunus cerasus - aurera* EVANS CHERRY**

A very hardy, vigorous tree with an upright and spreading habit, reaching 12-14' at maturity. Blooms in late spring. The bright red sour fruit ripens in early August. Zone 3.

***Prunus maackii 'Jefree'* GOLDRUSH AMUR CHERRY®**

A hybrid cherry that looks similar to Amur Cherry with a coppery-orange colour, and an upright to rounded-spreading crown form. This variety was selected for its improved resistance to frost cracking. Reaches 25'x16'. Zone 2.

***Prunus padus commutata* MAY DAY TREE**

A vigorous, rounded tree that produces clusters of fragrant, white flowers. Small, black fruit is attractive to birds. Mature height of 30"25'. Zone 2.

***Prunus pennsylvanica* MARY LISS PIN CHERRY**

A small tree, 13 to 15 ft. at maturity, with an upright sturdy trunk. Fruit is 12mm or larger with thin skin. Production is triple that of wild types. Zone 3.

***Prunus tomentosa* BLACK NANKING CHERRY**

An upright, spreading shrub with deeply veined green foliage. Reaches mature height of 10'. Tasty, black cherries are excellent for jellies. Zone 3.

***Prunus tomentosa* WHITE NANKING CHERRY**

Growing habit similar to Black Nanking Cherry. Mature height of 10'. Cherries are white and great for jellies. Zone 3.

***Prunus virginiana* BAILEY'S SELECT SCHUBERT CHERRY**

Vigorous, hardy uniform tree with a straight trunk. New foliage is green, changing to purple as it matures. White flowers produce small, black fruit that is attractive to birds. Reaches 25'x20'. Zone 2.

***Prunus virginiana* GARRINGTON CHOKECHERRY®**

A hardy variety with a bush type habit that reaches 8' at maturity. Produces large, black 10mm fruit. Zone 3.

***Prunus virginiana* MIDNIGHT SCHUBERT CHERRY**
